## RING SIZE GUIDE

You will be able to determine your ring size with the following chart.
Please remember that the ring you are using should be one worn on the same finger as the Mauboussin ring you are interested in. Choose a ring that is about the same width and that you wear on the same hand.
Place it on the nearest sized circle of this chart and once the edge on the inside of your ring falls on the edge of the circle, you have found your size.

The size in the circle is the European size, used by Mauboussin. The size at the bottom of the circle is the corresponding diameter in millimeters (mm).

If the ring falls between two sizes, we would advise you to choose the larger size.


Make sure that this page appears as "real size" onscreen. Or you can print this chart for your convenience and for best results; verify the printing options of your printer so that the "scale to fit" option is set to none in the print dialogue box.

This chart is indicative of the conversion between European sizes and the inside diameter of the ring in millimeters. Mauboussin cannot be held responsible for any errors that arise from using this ring size conversion chart.
